Due to Covid 19 the Rules meeting location on Friday 4/30/21 at 7pm: will be announced on the Harlan Anglers Facebook page the Friday before the rules meeting.

To qualify for the 2022 NTC by Cabela's must do the following:

- To **qualify** for any NTC slots provided by Cabela's for the 2022 NTC championship; both members of the Team fishing the H.A.W.C tournament must be a member of the Harlan Anglers club prior to fishing the tournament. NTC slots are dependant on slots awarded to the club by Cabela's.
- **H.A.W.C Membership Fee:** If you wish to join the H.A.W.C add \$20.00 per Team Member (family Membership) to entry fee and check the box for H.A.W.C membership. Total Fee is (\$320.00). **You do not have to be a member to fish the tournament.** If you do not want to be a member or wish to qualify for the Cabela's NTC FY21 slots the cost is \$280.00 per two-man team.
- **FY 22 Qualifying NTC slots:** given out from the H.A.W.C will be based on the highest combined weight total of the H.A.W.C tournament In case of a tie big fish will be used to break the tie.
- **Tournament Time:** 7:00 am to 4:00 pm. Saturday May 1st & Sunday May 2nd, 2021.
- **Entries:** Mail in Entries must be received by 4/26/2021 by 6:00 pm. Club will accept applications at the rules meeting 4/30/21 prior to the end of the meeting, but there will be a \$20.00 additional late fee added to the cost of the tournament. This means the cost of the tournament will be \$300

Walleye Tournament Rules and Regulations

1. Participants and Eligibility

2. Pre-Tournament Meeting

A. Pre-tournament meeting on April 30, 2021 at 7pm. At least one member of the team must attend the Rules meeting for the Harlan Anglers Walleye Tournament

3. Safety

- A. All participants are required to wear life jackets at the start of the tournament.**
- B. Contestants will be allowed to pull to the nearest shoreline in the event of a thunderstorm or an emergency.**

4. Fishing

- A. Tournament fishing hours are from 7am to 4pm for the Harlan Anglers tournament 5/1/2021 & 5/2/2021.**
- B. Weigh in slips must be validated before going fishing for the tournament.**
- C. All boats must pass pre-fish inspection.**
- D. Teams which leave before assigned times will be disqualified.**
- E. All teams must be in the weigh in area before prescribed times. A 10% penalty will be deducted from total weight for any team that is 1 to 10 minutes late for weigh in time. Any team over ten minutes late will be disqualified.**

5. Tackle and Equipment

- A. All Nebraska Regulations will apply to fishing methods and equipment. Any team caught fishing with more than 2 poles at a time per person are automatically disqualified from the H.A.W.C. Tournament.**
- B. CB or marine band radios and cell phones are allowed for emergency use only.**
- C. All fish weighed must be kept and carried in aerated live wells or coolers. The use of fish stringers, wire baskets or other means of keeping fish are prohibited.**
- D. All teams are subject to inspection by Tournament officials at any time.**

6. Fish Size and Limits

- A. Walleye are the only fish eligible.**
- B. Walleye—daily bag limit of 4 may include one walleye from 15 to 18 inches and 3 over 18 inches, or 4 over 18 inches, but no more than 1 over 22 inches in length allowed in daily bags. Boats may have 8 walleye in the live well and of the 5 fish weighed in, 2 fish may be between 15 inches and 18 inches, two 22 inches or longer along with the walleye in between 18 to 22 inches.**
- C. The tournament bag limit is 5 fish per two-man team**
- D. Sorting or culling of fish is prohibited and if caught will result in disqualification from the H.A.W.C. tournament.**

7. Scoring

-
- A. Prizes will be based on the most weight of walleyes caught in the tournament. Only live fish will be weighed (signs of gills moving) . If a dead fish is brought to the scale it will result in a disqualification for that day's total weight. Scales will be available beginning at 9am. Only weigh-in officials are permitted to touch fish on the measuring table.
 - B. Any fish frozen, mauled, mashed, stringered or showing any signs of tampering may result in disqualification at the discretion of tournament officials.
 - C. In the event of ties, final placing will be determined by the heaviest single fish.
 - D. Once the weight is given for the teams catch that day any team asking for a re-weigh if the second requested weight is smaller than the first weight the smaller weight will become the official weight for that team. If the weight is more that weight will be the official weight.
 - E. The big fish will be determined by the team member weighing in the fish. Once the big fish is weighed it cannot be replaced by another fish.
 - F. Fish Length Violations: Any team bringin to the weigh-in fish that do not meet the minimum length limits or too many fish over the 22 inch length limits will be automatically disqualified from the H.A.W.C tournament and subject to any fines by the Nebraska Games and Parks Commission

8. Miscellaneous

-
- A. In the interest of good sportsmanship, it is expected that competitors will not crowd or impede each other. Other than going to shore for adverse weather, not two contestants' boats may pull up to each other during tournament hours.
 - B. Patrol and Safety boats may pull up and inspect contestants at any time. Anyone found cheating will be immediately disqualified and the reason for that disqualification will be announced at weigh-in.
 - C. Disqualification for any reason will result in forfeiture of entry fee and qualification for NTC slots.
 - D. Fish may be weighed in at any time during the fishing hours. Only live and healthy fish will be weighed. All live fish will be released, once the basket of fish gets to the weight tank you cannot change or substitute a fish.
 - E. All fishing must be done from a tournament-inspected boat. Only two team members may occupy the boat. Tournament officials reserve the right to refuse entry to any individual or team.
 - F. All rules have "Loopholes." It is the intention of the Harlan Anglers Walleye Club, sponsors and helpers to provide an honest and sportsmanlike tournament.
